

Bip & Bop Scenario Cards

Teachers: Use these scenarios cards to play the Bip and Bop Healthy Relationships Game with your class. (Get complete instructions on the *Choices* Ideabook!)

Bop is sad because the family dog died last night. Bip doesn't care and only wants to talk about the soccer game.

*Being supportive is part of relationships:
Poke 3 holes in the paper with the pencil and add one rock*

Bop is comforting Bip because of a really bad grade on a test.

*Being supportive is an important part of a relationship:
Take off 2 rocks.*

Bip calls because practice went a little long and is going to be late. Bop gets mad and says "I'm not going to wait. I wait all the time!"

*Aggressive behavior and accusations:
Add 5 drops of water and a rock.*

Bop says the family is getting together this weekend and plans have to change. Bip is hurt, but understands.

*Being honest and understanding (even when feelings are hurt) is important:
Take off one rock.*

Bip and Bop have decided not to have sex because they aren't ready and haven't known each other very long.

*Mutual decision to postpone or abstain from sex:
Take off 2 rocks.*

Bip is honest when Bop asks: "What do you think of my friend Bo?" by saying: "I can see why you like Bo, but I like Bevis more."

*Honesty without hurtfulness:
Do Nothing*

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Bop admits to over-reacting about Bip not being able to come over this weekend.

*Admitting mistakes is good for relationships:
Take off one rock.*

Bip introduces Bop to every friend at the game to help them feel more comfortable with each other.

*Helping friends meet is a healthy action:
Take off one rock.*

Bip and Bop have an argument with name calling, yelling, and hurtful accusations.

*Aggressive behavior is a bad thing:
Poke 5 holes in the paper with the pencil.*

Bip checks Bop's text messages and sees texts about meeting someone else in secret.

*Violation of privacy and dishonesty:
Add 10 drops of water and poke 4 holes.*

Bip lies and says they are out with friends, when they are really out with someone else.

*Telling lies and being secretive:
Add a rock and 5 drops of water.*

Jealousy is a real problem, so much so that Bop doesn't trust Bip when they aren't together.

*Jealousy is NOT a sign of love. It is manipulative and shows insecurity:
Add 5 drops of water and a rock.*

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At school, there is an argument and Bip pushes Bop against the lockers and walks away angry.

*Physical abuse:
Add 3 rocks, 6 drops of water,
and 2 holes.*

Bip is making fun of Bop in front of their friends. It seems more mean than funny.

*This is hurtful, not supportive:
Add a rock and poke 3 holes.*

Bop says: "I don't want you wearing that to school anymore. It makes others stare at you."

*Telling someone what to wear or do is controlling and negative:
Add 5 drops of water and a rock.*

Bop and Bip are at a party. Bip goes out on the porch for some fresh air and sees Bop kissing someone else.

*Dishonesty and cheating:
Add 2 rocks and 5 drops of water.*

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
